Applications for special consideration must be submitted no later than the beginning of Week 15 of the semester.

In the case of an examination that is time-limited, students who believe that they have special circumstances which justify additional time may apply in writing to the Dean of their School for special consideration no later than the beginning of Week 15 of the semester.
