# UNITS ON OFFER SEMESTER 3, 2021



This document provides information regarding the units of study that are available to students in Christian Heritage College (CHC) courses in Semester 3, 2021. This information is made available to assist students with the calculation of tuition fees and student contribution amounts (as applicable) for units of study in Semester 3, 2021.

CHC reserves the right to remove units of study from offer, in which case CHC will contact students regarding alternative arrangements.

This document should be read in conjunction with the *Unit Costs 2021* and *EFTSL Values for Units of Study 2021* documents on the CHC website.

#### UNIT

The 'Unit' column shows the codes and titles of the units that are available in Semester 3, 2021. Units appear according to their areas of study and are categorised as 'Undergraduate' or 'Postgraduate' according to their level of study. The areas of study are as follows:

- Business
- Christian Studies

Humanities

Social Sciences

• Ministries

• Education

## DELIVERY MODE

The 'Delivery Mode' column shows the *modes of delivery* in which units are available, as follows:

- **intensive** denotes periodic on campus classes, usually consisting of two or three sessions of wholeday face-to-face contact during a semester; and
- **external/online** denotes distance education with no on campus classes.

For each mode, virtual classes might be scheduled from time to time using platforms such as Microsoft Teams and Zoom.

#### **CREDIT POINTS**

The 'Credit Points' column shows the number of *credit points* allocated to each unit. This represents the number of hours per week that students are normally expected to devote to studies in that unit across the semester. This includes (as applicable) attendance at on campus classes, participation in online classes, reading and preparation for classes, study and research, assessment work, etc.

A standard unit of 10 credit points has a semester workload of 150 hours and an EFTSL value of 0.125. Units that carry credit point weightings that are multiples of 10 have semester workloads and EFTSL values that are increased by the same factor.



## FEE-PAYING PLACES

A fee-paying place is a higher education place for which the cost of students' education is funded by students without government subsidy. Students who are in fee-paying places pay tuition fees.

The 'Fee-Paying Places' column shows the tuition fees payable by domestic students and the tuition fees payable by international students for units in which they enrol. Tuition fees are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in fee-paying places in an academic year, not to commencing students only.

## DOMESTIC TUITION FEES

The 'Domestic Tuition Fees' column shows the tuition fees that are payable by domestic students.

All domestic students at CHC (that is, Australian citizens, permanent residents, permanent humanitarian visa holders and New Zealand citizens) are enrolled in fee-paying places except for those courses listed under 'Commonwealth supported places' below.

#### INTERNATIONAL TUITION FEES

The 'International Tuition Fees' column shows the tuition fees that are payable by international students.

All international students at CHC (that is, onshore students who are studying in Australia under the provisions of a temporary visa issued by the Department of Home Affairs, such as a student visa, business visa or spousal visa, and offshore students who are studying in their home countries via external/online enrolment) are enrolled in fee-paying places.

#### COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES

A Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) is a higher education place for which the Australian government subsidises the cost of students' education. CSPs are available to domestic students only (see definition above). Students who are in CSPs pay student contribution amounts.

The 'Commonwealth Supported Places' column indicates the information that is used to determine the student contribution amounts that are payable by students who are in CSPs for units in which they enrol.

CSPs are available in the following CHC courses in Semester 3, 2021:

- Bachelor of Education (Primary) [ED21]
- Bachelor of Education (Secondary) [ED23]
- Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) [CC23]
- Graduate Certificate in School Leadership and Management [ED41]

#### FIELD OF EDUCATION and DISCIPLINE AREA

The 'Field of Education' and 'Discipline Area' columns indicate the *fields of education* and *discipline areas* into which units of study are classified according to the Australian Standard Classification of Education (ASCED). The Commonwealth government allocates these fields of education to funding clusters and assigns maximum annual student contribution amounts to clusters. ## CHC COURSES

The 'CHC Courses' column indicates the courses at CHC (by course code) in which units are available to students who are in CSPs.

Students whose course codes do not appear are not able to access a CSP and must pay tuition fees for the units (as applicable).

#### FUNDING CLUSTER

The 'Funding Cluster' column indicates the *funding clusters* to which units are allocated for students who commenced a course in a CSP at CHC on or after 1 January 2021<sup>1</sup>.

#### STUDENT AMOUNT

The 'Student Amount' column indicates the student contribution amounts that are payable by students who commenced a course in a CSP at CHC on or after 1 January 2021. Student contribution amounts are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in a post-1 January 2021 CSP in an academic year, not to commencing students only.

#### GRANDFATHERED FUNDING CLUSTER

The 'Grandfathered Funding Cluster' column indicates the funding clusters to which units are allocated for students who commenced a course in a CSP at CHC prior to 1 January 2021.

#### GRANDFATHERED STUDENT AMOUNT

The 'Grandfathered Student Amount' column indicates the student contribution amounts that are payable by students who commenced a course in a CSP at CHC prior to 1 January 2021. Student contribution amounts are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in a pre-1 January 2021 CSP in an academic year, not to commencing students only.

## PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES AND STUDENT CONTRIBUTION AMOUNTS

Tuition fees and student contribution amounts must be paid to CHC by the due date that is declared for each semester. The means by which tuition fees and student contribution amounts can be paid to CHC are indicated in the relevant sections of the Unit Costs 2021 document on the CHC website.

Eligible students can defer all or some of their tuition fees and student contribution amounts to FEE-HELP and HECS-HELP (respectively). Eligibility requirements for HELP are indicated in the relevant section of the Unit Costs 2021 document on the CHC website. Please note that accessing HELP does not mean that a student is in a Commonwealth supported place.

The funding clusters and student contribution amounts shown in this document reflect the funding arrangements included in the Commonwealth government's 'lob-ready Graduates' package of university reforms passed in 2020. Students who commenced their courses in CSPs on or after 1 January 2021 are subject to the new arrangements, while students who commenced their courses in CSPs prior to 1 January 2021 are subject to grandfathered arrangements.
