UNITS ON OFFERWINTER SEMESTER, 2022



This document provides information regarding units of study that are available in Christian Heritage College (CHC) courses in Winter Semester, 2022 and is intended to assist students with calculating their financial liability for the semester. It should be read in conjunction with the *Unit Costs 2022, Census Dates 2022* and *EFTSL Values for Units of Study 2022* documents on the CHC website. CHC reserves the right to amend the units of study on offer, in which case students will be contacted regarding alternative arrangements.

The CHC Ministries courses are delivered by Citipointe Ministry College under a third-party agreement.

Unit enrolments for Winter Semester, 2022 are scheduled to open on 3 May 2022.

The following information is provided with regard to the tables that appear on pages 4-5 of this document.

UNIT

The 'Unit' column shows the codes and titles of the units that are available in Winter Semester, 2022. Units appear according to their areas of study and are categorised as 'Undergraduate' or 'Postgraduate' according to their level of study.

Students who wish to undertake units that are indicated by '*' must contact their Course Coordinator prior to enrolling.

DELIVERY MODE

The 'Delivery Mode' column shows the *modes of delivery* in which units are available, as follows:

- internal denotes weekly on campus classes, usually comprising three hours of face-to-face contact per teaching week;
- **intensive** denotes periodic on campus classes, usually comprising two or three sessions of whole-day face-to-face contact during a semester; and
- **external/online** denotes distance education with no on campus classes.

In addition to the above arrangements, *online classes* might be scheduled for any mode using platforms such as Microsoft Teams and Zoom. All scheduled on campus and online classes will appear in students' timetables in their *MyCHC* portal.

CREDIT POINTS

The 'Credit Points' column shows the number of *credit points* allocated to each unit. This represents the number of hours per week that students are normally expected to devote to studies in that unit across the semester.

At CHC, a standard unit carries a credit point weighting of 10 credit points. Units that carry credit point weightings that are multiples of 10 have workloads that are increased by the same factor.

EFTSL VALUE

The 'EFTSL Value' column shows the *equivalent full-time student load (EFTSL) value* allocated to each unit. This represents the proportion of the unit in relation to a standard annual full-time study load in the course in which it is located.

A standard annual full-time study load in a course has an overall EFTSL value of 1.0 and a duration of 1200 hours. All CHC courses have a standard annual full-time study load of eight units, giving each standard unit an EFTSL value of 0.125 (1.0/8) and a workload of 150 hours (1200/8). This represents the total number of hours in a semester that students are normally expected to devote to studies in a unit. Units that have EFTSL values that are multiples of 0.125 have workloads that are increased by the same factor.







FEE-PAYING PLACES

A fee-paying place is a higher education place for which the cost of students' education is funded by students without government subsidy. Students who are in fee-paying places pay tuition fees.

The 'Fee-Paying Places' column shows the tuition fees payable by domestic students and the tuition fees payable by international students for units in which they enrol. Tuition fees are charged according to credit point weightings and EFTSL value. Units that have credit points that are multiples of 10 and EFTSL values that are multiples of 0.125 have tuition fees that are increased by the same factor.

Tuition fees are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in fee-paying places in that year, not to commencing students only.

DOMESTIC TUITION FEES

The 'Domestic Tuition Fees' column shows the tuition fees that are payable by domestic students.

All domestic students at CHC (Australian citizens, permanent residents, current and former permanent humanitarian visa holders and New Zealand citizens) are enrolled in fee-paying places except those who are enrolled in a course listed in the 'Commonwealth supported places' section below and who meet the criteria for being enrolled in a Commonwealth supported place.

INTERNATIONAL TUITION FEES

The 'International Tuition Fees' column shows the tuition fees that are payable by international students.

All international students at CHC (onshore students studying in Australia under the provisions of a temporary visa issued by the Department of Home Affairs, such as a student visa, business visa or spousal visa, and offshore students studying in their home countries via external/online enrolment) are enrolled in fee-paying places.

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES

A Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) is a higher education place for which the Australian government subsidises the cost of students' education. CSPs are available to domestic students only (see definition above). Students who are in CSPs pay student contribution amounts.

The 'Commonwealth Supported Places' column indicates the information that is used to determine the student contribution amounts that are payable by students who are in CSPs for units in which they enrol.

CSPs are available to eligible students in the following CHC courses in Semester 1, 2022:

- Undergraduate Certificate in Educational Studies [ED03]
- Undergraduate Certificate in Counselling Studies [SS09] (continuing students only)
- Bachelor of Education (Primary) [ED21]
- Bachelor of Education (Secondary) [ED23]
- Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) [CC23]
- Graduate Certificate in School Leadership and Management [ED41]
- Graduate Certificate in Counselling Studies [SS34]
- Master of Teaching (Primary) [ED54]
- Master of Teaching (Secondary) [ED55]

FIELD OF EDUCATION and DISCIPLINE AREA

The 'Field of Education' and 'Discipline Area' columns indicate the *fields of education* and *discipline areas* into which units are classified according to the Australian Standard Classification of Education (ASCED). The Commonwealth government allocates these fields of education to funding clusters and assigns maximum annual student contribution amounts to each of the clusters (see below).

CHC COURSES

The 'CHC Courses' column indicates the CHC courses (by course code) in which units are available to students who are enrolled in CSPs. Courses that do not appear do not have CSPs allocated to them, and students must pay tuition fees (as applicable) for the units.

FUNDING CLUSTER

The 'Funding Cluster' column indicates the *funding clusters* to which units are allocated for students who commenced a CHC course in a CSP **on or after 1 January 2021**¹.

STUDENT AMOUNT

The 'Student Amount' column indicates the *student contribution amounts* that are payable by students who commenced a CHC course in a CSP **on or after 1 January 2021**. Student contribution amounts are charged according to credit point weighting and EFTSL value. Units that have credit points that are multiples of 10 and EFTSL values that are multiples of 0.125 have student contribution amounts that are increased by the same factor.

Student contribution amounts are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in a post-1 January 2021 CSP in that year, not to commencing students only.

GRANDFATHERED FUNDING CLUSTER

The 'Grandfathered Funding Cluster' column indicates the *funding clusters* to which units are allocated for students who commenced a CHC course in a CSP **prior to 1 January 2021**.

GRANDFATHERED STUDENT AMOUNT

The 'Grandfathered Student Amount' column indicates the *student contribution amounts* that are payable by students who commenced a CHC course in a CSP **prior to 1 January 2021**. Units that have credit points that are multiples of 10 and EFTSL values that are multiples of 0.125 have Student contribution amounts that are increased by the same factor

Student contribution amounts are reviewed each year and apply to all students who are enrolled in a pre-1 January 2021 CSP in that year, not to commencing students only.

PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES AND STUDENT CONTRIBUTION AMOUNTS

Tuition fees and student contribution amounts must be paid to CHC by the due date that is declared for each semester. The means by which tuition fees and student contribution amounts can be paid to CHC are indicated in the relevant sections of the *Unit Costs 2021* document on the CHC website.

Eligible students in a fee-paying place can defer all or some of their tuition fees to FEE-HELP, and eligible students in a Commonwealth supported place can defer all or some of their student contribution amounts to HECS-HELP. Eligibility requirements for HELP are indicated in the relevant section of the *Unit Costs 2021* document on the CHC website. *Please note that accessing a HELP loan is a separate arrangement to, and is not the same as, being in a Commonwealth supported place*.

¹ The arrangements shown reflect the Commonwealth government's university reforms passed in 2020. Students who commenced their courses in CSPs on or after 1 January 2021 are subject to the new arrangements, while students who commenced their courses in CSPs prior to 1 January 2021 are subject to grandfathered arrangements.
