

# UNIT SELECTION GUIDE

## LAUNCH PROGRAM

### Semester 1, 2020



Dear Student,

Congratulations and welcome to the LAUNCH program at Christian Heritage College (CHC). The purpose of this guide is to assist you with your unit selection for Semester 1, 2020. As part of the LAUNCH program you can study one CHC unit per semester during Years 11 and 12 (to a maximum of three units) and the units you complete successfully may count towards your Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

Not only does this program let you 'Look At Us Now – Christian Heritage' (LAUNCH), it is designed to *launch* you into your higher education studies by letting you experience life as a CHC student while still enrolled in your secondary school studies. The program also acts as a pathway of admission to your higher education studies: when you successfully complete a LAUNCH unit, you automatically meet the academic entry requirements for admission to the related undergraduate course at CHC following your completion of Year 12 (other entry requirements may also apply). If you are accepted into this course, you will also receive credit towards your degree for the related LAUNCH unit(s) you have successfully completed.

As a LAUNCH student, you will be part of a class of first year CHC undergraduate students. The LAUNCH program is normally offered outside of school hours, and you will need to attend all of the required classes for the unit. LAUNCH units normally require three hours of on-campus contact per week and it is recommended that you undertake an additional seven hours of personal study each week (a total of 10 hours per week). This includes aspects such as scheduled contact time, personal study, preparation of assessment tasks and examinations (as applicable). Unit outlines include a breakdown of these aspects as they apply to each unit.

While it is recommended that you engage in the on-campus LAUNCH program to immerse yourself in life as a CHC student, some LAUNCH units are available externally. You do not need to attend any classes for external units, but you do need to ensure that you engage in the learning materials for approximately 10 hours per week via the Moodle learning platform.

Just remember that these commitments are on top of your Year 11 and/or Year 12 study program.

#### **Selecting your unit**

To select your LAUNCH unit for Semester 1, 2020 you must complete the online *Unit Selection* form at the link provided in your offer materials. To log in to the *Unit Selection* form, you will need to enter your CHC student number, surname and date of birth. Once you have logged in, the units that are available to you in the LAUNCH program for this semester, and the mode(s) in which they are being delivered, will be displayed.

### Changing your unit selection

If you wish to change your enrolment after submitting your online *Unit Selection* form, you must submit a completed *Application for Change to Unit Selection* form (available on the CHC website). Changes to your unit selection may have an effect upon transcript data, depending upon the date on which any such changes are made, as outlined in the table below.

### Census date

The census dates that apply to each semester are declared by CHC in the *Student Handbook* and on the CHC website.

The census date is the date in each semester on which all enrolment information is to be finalised. No changes can be made to enrolment information after this date, except those allowed by Commonwealth legislation.

The census date for Semester 1, 2020 is **Wednesday, 18 March**.
