Students who wish to apply for special consideration with regard to end-of-semester examinations and presentations are to consult the CHC [Examinations](#) policy for the process by which applications are made. Applications for special consideration must be submitted no later than the beginning of **Week 13** of the semester.

Examinations that are **time-limited** are those in which extra time is not permitted. In the case of an examination that is time-limited, students who believe that they have special circumstances which justify additional time may apply in writing to the Dean of their School for special consideration no later than the beginning of **Week 13** of the semester.

The conditions under which students may apply for a deferred examination are described in the CHC [Examinations](#) policy.
