This information is made available to current and prospective students to assist with the calculation of tuition fees and student contribution amounts (as applicable) for units of study at CHC in Semester 3, 2020. This information should be read in conjunction with the [Unit Costs](#) and [EFTSL Values for Units of Study](#) documents on the CHC website.

Christian Heritage College (CHC) reserves the right to remove units of study from offer, in which case CHC will contact students regarding alternative arrangements.

The information appearing on the following pages lists the units of study that are available to students at CHC in Semester 3, 2020 according to their fields of study, as follows: LAUNCH; Business; Christian Studies; Education; Humanities and Liberal Arts; Ministries; and Social Sciences.

The *mode of delivery* and *credit point weighting* are indicated for each unit of study. These are explained below. Information regarding the *funding cluster* to which selected units of study belong is also provided.

MODES OF DELIVERY

The *modes of delivery* used in this document are as follows:

- **intensive** – denotes on campus classes held as sessions of whole-day face-to-face contact during a semester (virtual classes might be scheduled from time to time); and
- **external/online** – denotes distance education with no on campus classes (virtual classes might be scheduled from time to time).

CREDIT POINT WEIGHTING

The *credit point weighting* indicates the number of hours per week that students would normally be expected to devote to studies in each unit of study across the semester. This includes (as applicable) attendance at on campus classes, participation in online classes, reading and preparation for classes, study and research, assessment work, etc.

FUNDING CLUSTERS

Funding clusters are relevant only to units of study that are available to students who are enrolled in initial teacher education courses in Commonwealth supported places (Bachelor of Education and Master of Teaching courses).

Absence of the funding cluster against a unit of study indicates that it is not available to students in initial teacher education courses.



CALCULATING TUITION FEES AND STUDENT CONTRIBUTION AMOUNTS

To calculate the tuition fees or student contribution amount for a unit of study, please refer to the relevant pages of the [Unit Costs](#) document on the CHC website, according to the following guidelines:

- If you are a domestic student in a *fee-paying place*, locate the relevant information and table of tuition fees to determine the fees for the unit according to your course of study (pages 1-3 of the [Unit Costs](#) document). Tuition fees are charged according to the courses in which students are enrolled. Where units of study are offered in multiple courses, domestic students pay tuition fees as applicable to their course of study, not to the courses in which units of study are housed for administrative purposes.
- If you are a domestic student in a *Commonwealth supported place* (Bachelor of Education and Master of Teaching courses only), locate the relevant information and table of student contribution amounts to determine the amount for the unit of study according to its funding cluster (pages 3-4 of the [Unit Costs](#) document). Student contribution amounts are charged according to the funding clusters into which units of study are classified by Australian government guidelines as determined by their field of education, not by a student's course of study. This means that units of study within a student's course can have different student contribution amounts if these units of study are located in different funding clusters. Information regarding the allocation of units of study to funding clusters for 2020 is available from the [Department of Education, Skills and Employment](#).
- If you are an international student, locate the relevant information and table of tuition fees to determine the fees for the unit of study according to your course of study (pages 5-6 of the [Unit Costs](#) document).

PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES AND STUDENT CONTRIBUTION AMOUNTS

The means by which tuition fees and student contribution amounts can be paid are indicated in the relevant sections of the [Unit Costs](#) document on the CHC website.

HECS-HELP assistance is available for all units of study in the Bachelor of Education (Primary), Bachelor of Education (Secondary), Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Education (Secondary), Master of Teaching (Primary) and Master of Teaching (Secondary), subject to the meeting of personal eligibility requirements.

FEE-HELP assistance is available for all units of study in all other CHC courses, subject to the meeting of personal eligibility requirements. No limits or conditions on the FEE-HELP assistance available for units of study in these courses have been imposed on CHC's approval as a higher education provider.
